In an effort to educate and increase awareness of preventive healthcare, ENA plans to provide members and conventioners the following services during the 2009 Convention in San Francisco from September 4, 2009 to September 7, 2009.

Objectives:

- A. To provide a free comprehensive medical screening to Edo State indigenes of all ages
- B. Medical screening will be overseen by Board certified physicians, clinical experts, Nurses, Nurse practitioners, and Pharmacists
- C. Screening will include:
 - Height and weight measurements
 - Body mass indexes
 - Blood pressure measurements
 - Screening for Diabetes (Glucose monitoring)
 - Electrocardiogram readings for high risk groups.
- D. Provide medical/ educational materials on common diseases such as:
 - Hypertension
 - Sudden Cardiac Death
 - Diabetes
 - Sickle Cell Anemia
- E. Provide valuable information to Edo State indigenes living in the U.S on where and how to get State of the Art medical care to relatives and friends living in Nigeria
- F. Medical Networking – To assist foreign graduates of Edo State origin on how to get spots in US residency programs and medical schools
- G. Provide an avenue to disseminate free medical, surgical and pharmaceutical advice to members of the Edo State community
